Update on progress with GiveWell Labs (Alexander)

Initial ("super shallow") investigations

- Chose 5 topics to conduct initial investigations for, aiming to cover diverse questions and causes
- Aiming to spend 10-15 hours on initial investigation, including 2-3 conversations with experts in the field and drafting write-up, then assess what we were able to learn
- Status of 5 initial investigations
 - Nuclear safety
 - Had 3 conversations, including one with Carnegie Endowment for International Peace
 - Read overview of the field
 - Drafted write up
 - We have a good idea of how much money is in it from US foundations, but don't know how that money is being spent
 - Business regulation in developing countries
 - Had 1 conversation, looking for next person to talk to
 - Road safety in developing countries
 - Setting up conversations
 - Criminal justice reform
 - Setting up conversations
 - Antibiotic resistance
 - Had 1 conversation, setting up another

Meta-research

- Holden is writing a blog post on open science
- We'll be making a decision soon about which, if any, conferences to go to in September

Medium-depth investigations

- We're working to find contractors who could conduct medium-depth investigations for a few causes:
 - Increasing labor mobility (migration)
 - Geoengineering research
 - Malaria (including net distributions, R&D on drugs, vaccines, and insecticides, research on nets and insecticide resistance, malaria control and elimination)
- We had previously considered finding contractors for medium-depth investigations of water and nutrition, but have deprioritized those because we are not at the point where we would want to contract out further work in those areas.
