GiveDirectly (Eliza)

Scientific research (Holden)

Staff continued the discussion from the previous week about GiveWell's approach to learning about scientific research. Holden reviewed the process that lead him to choose biomedical research as the first broad focus area within science. Holden explained that one of his primary goals in the conversations he is conducting with funders, scientific researchers, and other related professionals is to collect perspectives on what type of science funding is needed, and where the problems are in the existing funding structure for research.
